We may collect and process the following information:

Sharing Your Information

We do not sell personal information.

We may share information with:

Data Security

Data Retention

Customer records and project information may be retained for up to 7 years following completion of works.

Enquiry form submissions may be retained for up to 24 months.

Financial records may be retained for up to 7 years in accordance with HMRC requirements.

Marketing consent records may be retained for as long as necessary to demonstrate compliance with applicable legislation.

Your Rights
